BEGINNING DANCE

Explore the design process, and learn hand-building ceramics techniques and how to use various hand and power tools. ANIMATION WORKSHOP SATURDAYS 10:00AM - 1:00PM

Learn various techniques of producing animation, including high-tech and low-tech approaches such as optical toys, flash, clay, paint on glass, charcoal, sand, paper collage, erasure, Photoshop, and more. This program will also include filmmaking principles such as: editing, analyzing, planning (pre-production), production techniques, and post-production development. For all levels of experience; this year-long class runs until Spring 2017.
