Inner-City Arts Summer Creativity Camp is a full day experience for elementary aged students 6-12 years that allows their imaginations to blossom through the visual, performing and media arts. Our experienced teaching artists will lead students in hands-on arts engagement.

Art forms include:

- **Visual Arts**—Drawing, Painting, Sculpture
- **Media Arts**—Filmmaking, Graphic Design, Photography
- **Performing Arts**—Dance, Playmaking
- STEAM in our **Creativity Lab**

In addition to artist-guided instruction, students will make new friends and free play on our beautiful downtown campus. Guest artists, performances, and a field trip will round out a summer of fun and pure creative expression!

Visual Arts

Visual Arts focus on the elements and principles of visual arts that include line, shape color, space, texture, pattern, rhythm, balance, and contrast. Youth will explore of a wide variety of media and techniques such as drawing, painting and sculpture, developing basic skills, visual awareness, mindfulness, and creative self-expression.

Media Arts

Media Arts focus on the creative process while providing an opportunity for students to learn computer software. Through creativity, exploration, and the development of problem-solving skills, students will have an opportunity to increase their confidence, appreciation and knowledge of media arts. Photography, graphic design, and filmmaking will be explored through the lens of storytelling.

Performing Arts

Performing Arts will focus on creative expression through drama, dance and music. In drama, students will be working in groups to create short plays. Dance will highlight original moves and choreography. In music, participants will express themselves through voice and explore instruments.
